We have a presence on the British Pest Control Association (our industry body) and currently have our staff represented on the BPCA Executive Board, the Technical, Outreach & Communications and Equality, Diversity and Inclusion committees. We are also represented on the Royal Society for the Protection of Health advisory panel.

After graduating from the University of London in 2015 with a BMUS, James joined Beaver Pest Control in 2016 where his potential was quickly recognised.

In 2017 he gained a further 5 qualifications before becoming a Service Manager in 2018 where he managed a team of 6 technicians. James's technical knowledge impressed the Directors at Beaver and he was given the opportunity to set up the certified RSPH level 2 training centre, where James delivers technical training to both internal and external recruits. In 2021 he was promoted to Head of Training and Compliance. He also sits on the BPCA Technical committee where he has input into the codes of best practice for the industry as well as providing advice on the RSPH sector advisory panel.
